

Constitution of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation whose only voting members are its charity trustees

(‘Foundation’ model constitution)

1. Name

The name of the Charitable Incorporated Organisation (“the CIO”) is

1. National location of principal office

The CIO must have a principal office in England or Wales. The principal office of the CIO is in England.

2. Objects

The objects of the CIO are

For the public benefit, to advance education and awareness of the protection, conservation and sustainable improvement of inland and coastal water quality across England and Wales.

To improve public understanding of water pollution, wastewater management, and the roles and responsibilities of public authorities, regulators, companies and other stakeholders in safeguarding the water environment.

Nothing in this constitution shall authorise an application of the property of the CIO for the purposes which are not charitable in accordance with section 7 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and section 2 of the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008.
